Ethical Dilemmas and Professional Boundaries

Interpreters are bound by strict ethical codes, yet they often face challenging situations that test these boundaries. Deciding how to remain impartial while facilitating sensitive communications or managing dual relationships requires careful judgment and can be emotionally taxing.

Identity Strain

Interpreters frequently navigate complex social dynamics, balancing their role as a neutral conduit with their own personal identity. This can lead to feelings of identity confusion or strain, especially in situations where personal beliefs may conflict with the message being interpreted

Auditory and Visual Fatigue

Interpreters often experience significant fatigue from constantly processing and translating linguistic information through both auditory and visual channels. This continuous high-level cognitive load can lead to mental exhaustion, reduced concentration, and increased error rates

Here are four reflective prompts for you to consider

Prompt 1: Auditory & Visual Fatigue

How do you personally recognize the signs of mental fatigue—such as *reduced focus* or *increased irritability*—during a long interpreting assignment? What are some immediate, in-the-moment strategies you use to mitigate these effects?


Prompt 2: Identity Strain
